CANADA-NEWFOUNDLAND AND LABRADOR OFFSHORE PETROLEUM BOARD CALL FOR BIDS No. NL11-01

The Canada-Newfoundland and Labrador Offshore Petroleum Board hereby gives notice of the terms and conditions of the interests issued as a result of Call for Bids No. NL11-01. The bids selected, and the information contained on the prescribed bid forms, were published in *The Newfoundland and Labrador Gazette*, on December 9, 2011.

This notice is made pursuant to and subject to the *Canada-Newfoundland Atlantic Accord Implementation Act*, S.C., 1987, c3, and the *Canada-Newfoundland and Labrador Atlantic Accord Implementation Newfoundland and Labrador Act*, RSNL, 1990, cC-2.

Exploration Licence Nos. 1127 and 1128 were issued to the following interest owners:

The following is a summary of the terms and conditions of the above exploration licences:

1. The exploration licences confer:

- (a) the right to explore for, and the exclusive right to drill and test for, petroleum;

- (b) the exclusive right to develop those portions of the offshore area in order to produce petroleum; and
 - (c) the exclusive right, subject to compliance with the other provisions of the Act, to obtain a production licence.
2. The exploration licences were issued for a nine-year term effective January 15, 2012.
3. Period I is a period of five (5) years commencing on the effective date of this licence. The interest owner shall commence the drilling of the well within Period I, and diligently pursue such drilling thereafter, as a condition precedent to obtaining tenure during Period II.
4. The interest owner may at its option extend Period I from five (5) years to six (6) years by providing to the Board before the end of the fifth year of Period I either:
- (a) a description of 50% contiguous Licence Lands to be surrendered together with a refundable drilling deposit of \$250,000;

OR

- (b) a \$1,000,000 refundable drilling deposit.

A drilling deposit posted pursuant to paragraph (a) or (b) above will be refunded in full if the Licence is validated for Period II by the drilling of a well on that licence. No interest will be paid on the drilling deposit.

If a validation well is not drilled, the drilling deposit will be forfeited to the Receiver General for Canada upon termination of the Licence at the end of Period I. Allowable Expenditures cannot be applied against the Drilling Deposit.

5. Upon the expiration of Period II, there shall be a deemed surrender of the interest except as it relates to the lands or any portion thereof subject to a significant discovery licence, or a production licence.

A credit against the deposit will be made following each anniversary date of each respective exploration licence on the basis of 25% of allowable expenditures. 7. For each licence, rentals will be applicable only in Period II at a rate of \$5.00 per hectare in respect of the first year and increasing thereafter by \$2.50 per hectare per year, up to and including the third year. Rentals for the fourth year will be \$7.50 per hectare.

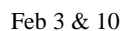

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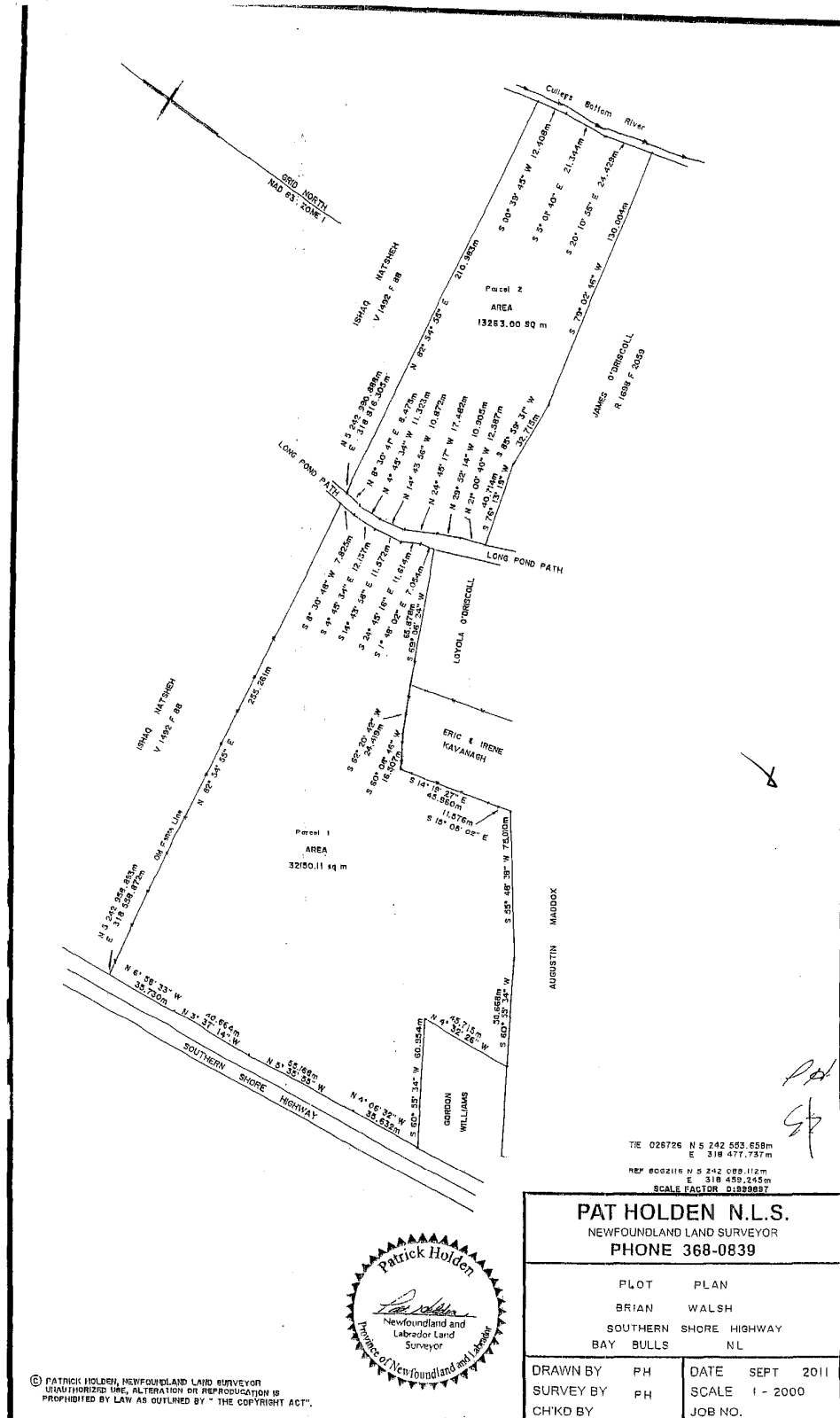

1. Subsection 15(2) of the Schedule to the *Buildings Accessibility Regulations* is repealed and the following substituted:

(2) Vertical signs shall be

- (a) at least 300 millimetres by 600 millimetres;
- (b) permanently installed on a permanent post, building or structure at a height of 1500 millimetres from the ground or floor surface to the centre of the sign;
- (c) visible to the public; and
- (d) maintained in a state of good repair.

Transitional

2. (1) A building which is subject to the Act and the Regulations and which was completed or partially completed before these regulations came into force shall comply with these regulations by September 30, 2012.

(2) A proposed building which is subject to the Act and the Regulations and for which a building accessibility design registration application was submitted before these regulations came into force shall comply with these regulations by September 30, 2012.

Commencement

3. These regulations come into force on February 15, 2012.

1. Rule 57.11 Amdt.
Applications respecting initiation of appeal

1. Rule 57.11 of the *Rules of the Supreme Court, 1986* is amended by adding immediately after rule 57.11(1) the following:

(2) Every notice of appeal, application or response to either, that involves a question of custody of, access to, protection of, responsibility for or support of a child or children shall have noted in the top left corner, between the name of the court and the style of cause, the words "THIS MATTER INVOLVES A CHILD".

(3) Within 14 days of every filing or other step taken in a proceeding to which rule 57.11(2) applies, the Deputy Registrar shall, after consultation with counsel or the party involved, advise the Chief Justice of the status of the proceeding and, insofar as it may have been ascertained, the intention of counsel or the party with respect to furthering the proceeding.

(4) On instruction from the Chief Justice, the Deputy Registrar may, by notice given in writing, orally or electronically to all known counsel or the party where a party's counsel is not known, specify a time by which any further step or steps in the proceeding is or are required to be taken, notwithstanding anything to the contrary specified elsewhere in these rules.

(5) In the event of failure of counsel or a party to conform to a requirement specified under rule 57.11(4) above, the Deputy Registrar will, on not less than 2 days' notice to counsel or the party where that party's counsel is not known, set the matter of management of the proceeding down for a hearing before a judge of the Court, who may give directions and make orders as he or she considers appropriate.

(6) Notwithstanding rules 57.11(3), (4) and (5), the Chief Justice or a judge may, at any time, make any orders or give any directions he or she considers appropriate to ensure any matter to which rule 57.11(2) applies proceeds to a hearing as expeditiously as the circumstances allow.
