



NR 93/97 as amended 1. The Newfoundland and Labrador T'Railway Provincial Park Proclamation is amended by adding at the end of the Schedule the following:

The area described in this Schedule is decreased by removing the following parcel of land:

All that piece or parcel of land lying north of St. Aidens Road, in the City of Corner Brook, in the Electoral District of Humber West, in the

Province of Newfoundland and Labrador, being further bounded and described as follows, that is to say:

Beginning at a survey marker on the northerly limit of St. Aidens Road, the said survey marker being the westerly angle of the herein described parcel of land, the said angle having co-ordinates of north 5,424,487.027 and east 343,088.167;
