

Mineral Regulations (Amendment) under the Mineral Act

(Filed January 15, 2012)

Under the authority of section 41.1 of the *Mineral Act*, I make the following regulations.

1. Schedule A of the *Mineral Regulations* is amended by adding immediately after paragraph HHHH the following:

IIII. All that piece or parcel of land and land under water situate and being in the general area of Julienne Lake in the province and being described as follows:

Beginning at a point that point having UTM co-ordinates of 5,886,000 metres north, 655,500 metres east;

Then south 17,500 metres;

Then west approximately 500 metres to the eastern boundary of mining lease 125 (223M);

Then north approximately 2,400 metres along the eastern boundary of mining lease 125 (223M) to the southern boundary of mining lease 132 (223M);

Then east approximately 500 metres along the southern boundary of mining lease 132 (223M);

Then north approximately 300 metres along the eastern boundary of mining lease 132 (223M);

Then east approximately 1,000 metres along the southern boundary of mining lease 132 (223M);

Then north approximately 3,300 metres, a portion of which is along the eastern boundary of mining lease 132 (223M);

Then east 1,500 metres;

Then south 500 metres;

Then west 500 metres;

Then south 500 metres:

Then west 500 metres;

Then south 500 metres;

Then east 1,000 metres;

Then south 1,000 metres;

Then east 4,000 metres;

Then south 500 metres;

Then east 1,000 metres to the point of beginning.
