NOTICE OF REGISTRATION TOWN OF GRAND FALLS-WINDSOR DEVELOPMENT REGULATIONS AMENDMENT NO. 2, 2013

TAKE NOTICE that the TOWN OF GRAND FALLS-WINDSOR Development Regulations Amendment No. 2, 2013, adopted on the 9th day of July, 2013, has been registered by the Minister of Municipal Affairs.

In general terms, the TOWN OF GRAND FALLS-WINDSOR Development Regulations Amendment No. 2, 2013 deal with the following changes: (1) to add to the Definition - Subsidiary Residential Apartment that if a single family residential dwelling is not owner occupied, a subsidiary residential unit can be permitted if it is situated in the basement; (2) to add to Regulation 3.6 -Discretionary Consideration of Development Permit Applications that proposed applications will be advertised in the local newspaper, letters to be sent to the property owners within the notification area, and for Authority to allow a minimum of 7 days for response; (3) to clarify and add to Regulation 7.5 (3) that the eaves of all accessory buildings and other structures must maintain a minimum setback distance of 0.3m (1ft) from any power line easement area within the property boundaries. If the easement area is outside the property boundaries, then lot line setbacks are in effect; (4) to add to Regulation 28.4 -CG And Principal Building(s) Development Standards Table the maximum height of 15m (49.2ft) for a hotel building in the Commercial General Zone.

The amendments come into legal effect on the day that this notice is published in *The Newfoundland and Labrador Gazette*. NOTICE OF REGISTRATION TOWN OF PARADISE DEVELOPMENT REGULATIONS AMENDMENT No. 72, 2013

TAKE NOTICE that the TOWN OF PARADISE Development Regulations Amendment No. 72, 2013, adopted by Council on the 16th day of July 2013, has been registered by the Minister of Municipal Affairs.

In general terms, the amendment rezones land located along St. Thomas Line, approximately 160m northeast of the intersection with Whelan's Crescent from Residential Subdivision Area (RSA) to Residential Low Density (RLD). The intent of the amendment is to accommodate a

comprehensive development plan for a 49-lot serviced residential subdivision.

ST. JOHN'S URBAN REGION REGIONAL PLAN AMENDMENT No. 1, 2013

The Minister of Municipal Affairs has approved St. John's Urban Region Regional Plan Amendment No. 1, 2013. The amendment re-designates land along St. Thomas Line, approximately 160m northeast of the intersection with Whelan's Crescent from "Rural" to "Urban Development." This Regional Plan Amendment was required in order for the Town to proceed with Development Regulations Amendment No. 72, 2013.

The municipal amendments come into effect on the day that this notice is published in *The Newfoundland and Labrador Gazette*. 
