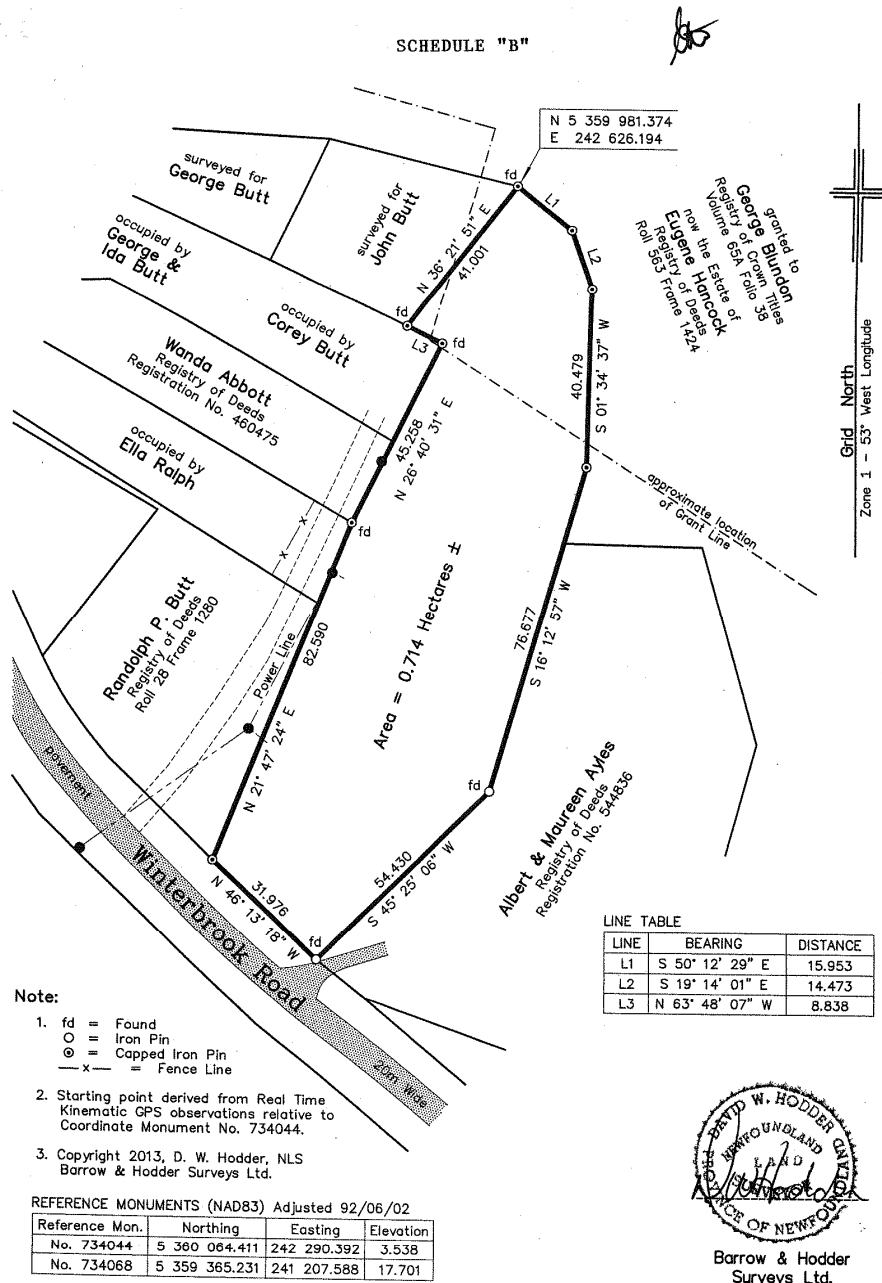

Short title

1. This order may be cited as the *Glover Island Public Reserve Order, 2013*.

Purpose

2. The Glover Island Public Reserve is established for the purpose of protecting the habitat of the Newfoundland Marten (*Martes americana atrata*).

Area included

3. The area included in the Glover Island Public Reserve is set out in the Schedule.

Term

4. The Glover Island Public Reserve is established for a 10 year period.

Repeal

5. The *Glover Island Public Reserve Order, Newfoundland and Labrador Regulation 86/02*, is repealed.

Schedule

All those pieces or parcels of land situated and being at Glover Island, in the Electoral Districts of Humber East, Grand Falls-Windsor-Buchans and St. George's-Stephenville East in the Province of Newfoundland and Labrador, abutted and bounded as follows, that is to say:

Beginning at a point on the northeasterly shoreline of Glover Island, that point being 90 metres above mean sea level where a brook flows into Grand Lake and having coordinates east 460 209.900 metres, north 5 416 240.146 metres, more or less;

Then running along the sinuosities of the shoreline of Glover Island in a general clockwise direction at 90 metres above mean sea level for a distance of 86.386 kilometres, more or less, to the point of beginning.

The above described piece or parcel of land being subject to a Newfoundland and Labrador Hydro Line Easement 38.1 metres wide, extending through the land in the northeast along the existing transmission line from east 460 806.291 metres, north 5 412 807.808 metres, to east 457 059.565 metres, north 5 414 079.338 metres, more or less.

The above described piece or parcel of land containing 176.503 kilometres squared, more or less.

Reserving and excepting out of the above described pieces or parcels of land, however, all those pieces or parcels of land lawfully alienated from the Crown.

All bearings and coordinates being referred to Zone 21 of the Universal Transverse Mercator Projection, North American Datum 1983.

1. (1) Section 2 of the *Glover Island Public Reserve Regulations* is amended by adding immediately before paragraph (a) the following:

(a.01) "managing agency" means the Parks and Natural Areas Division of the Department of Environment and Conservation;

(2) Paragraph 2(d) of the regulations is repealed and the following substituted:

- (d) "structure" means a man-made object intended to be permanent or semi-permanent in nature and includes buildings, houses, cottages, cabins, wharves, docks, boathouses, slipways, trailers, mobile homes, tent platforms, shelters and recreational vehicles used for any purpose but does not include temporary equipment associated with scientific research or monitoring, or signs erected by the managing agency;

2. Subsection 4(2) of the regulations is amended by deleting the words "responsible for the *Wilderness and Ecological Reserves Act*".

3. Subsections 5(3) and (4) of the regulations are repealed.

4. The regulations are amended by adding immediately after section 9 the following:

Scientific research

10. (1) A person shall not conduct scientific research within the reserve without a permit issued under subsection (2).

(2) Upon submission of a written request outlining the scientific research, the managing agency may issue a permit for scientific research on terms and conditions that the managing agency considers appropriate.

(3) A permit issued under subsection (2) may exempt the permit holder from paragraphs 3(a), (c) and (e).

42.4 (1) The Retirement Benefit Plan for the Employees of the City of St. John's is exempt from the requirement of paragraph 12(3)(d) for the period of December 31, 2012 to December 31, 2015 in respect of the solvency deficiency of the plan.

(2) Notwithstanding subsection (1), in the event of the termination of the plan, an amount that would have been payable under paragraph 12(3)(d) had the exemption not been given shall be paid by the City of St. John's to the fund.
