NOTICE OF REGISTRATION CITY OF CORNER BROOK DEVELOPMENT REGULATIONS AMENDMENTS DR13-03 TO DR13-08

TAKE NOTICE that the CITY OF CORNER BROOK Development Regulations Amendments, adopted on the 18th day of November, 2013, have been registered by the Minister of Municipal Affairs. In general terms, the purpose of the Development Regulations Amendments are:

DR13-03 - to remove the maximum frontage standard from the single, double and row dwelling categories in the Residential Medium Density, Residential High Density, and Townsite Residential Use Zone Tables.

DR13-04 - to remove the maximum building line setback standard from the single, double and row dwelling categories in the Residential Special Density, Residential Low Density, Residential Medium Density, Residential High Density, Mobile/Mini Home Residential, and Townsite Residential Use Zone Tables.

DR13-05 – to add new sections and change existing sections of Condition 10. Garden Suites, of the Residential Special Density Use Zone Table, that will: change the current maximum floor area permitted in order to develop larger garden suites; to allow garden suites to be developed as attached structures to other accessory buildings on the same lot; to remove the condition that garden suites be capable of being removed from, or relocated to another location on the lot; and where the main dwelling is at a greater and sufficient distance from the minimum building line setback, a garden suite may be able to be located in front of the main building on the lot, provided that it does

not project into the minimum building line setback area and is in keeping with the building line of the surrounding residential properties.

DR13-06 - to correct a zone label error on Land Use Zoning Map C-2 that incorrectly identifies an area of land as being Residential Commercial Mix rather than the proper zone designation of Residential Medium Density. The label will be changed from "RCM" to "RMD" at the affected location on the map.

DR13-07 - to correct typographical errors in the Residential Special Density and Residential High Density Use Zone Tables affecting the lot coverage standard. In both tables the word "minimum" is used to describe the percentage of lot coverage instead of the correct word "maximum".

DR13-08 - to correct typographical errors within Condition 2. Lot Layout and Designation sections (d) and (f), in order to ensure consistency between the text and supporting illustrations. As well, a word must be removed from (f) in order to properly represent the design guidelines.

The Corner Brook Development Regulations Amendments DR13-03 to DR13-08 comes into effect on the day that this notice is published in *The Newfoundland and Labrador Gazette*. Anyone who wishes to inspect a copy of the Corner Brook Development Regulations DR13-03 to DR13-08 may do so at City Hall, Corner Brook during normal business hours.



(2) A point of sale sign shall be posted or displayed in a tanning facility within one metre of every cash register or sales counter where access to tanning equipment is sold and shall be in the form and contain the information prescribed by the minister.

(3) A tanning equipment sign shall be posted or displayed in a tanning facility within one metre of each piece of tanning equipment and shall be in the form and contain the information prescribed by the minister.

7. A tanning facility shall have eye protection that meets the spectral transmittance requirements under the *Radiation Emitting Devices Act* (Canada) and the regulations made under that Act available for persons who access its tanning equipment.

Prohibited tanning equipment

Protective eyewear at tanning facilities

8. (1) Tanning equipment shall not be used in a tanning facility where

- (a) a person who purchases access to the tanning equipment may activate, turn on or program the tanning equipment;
- (b) the tanning equipment is a self-service device that upon insertion of one or more coins, tokens or cards automatically activates, turns on or is programmed; or
- (c) the tanning equipment does not automatically shut off after the time to access the tanning equipment purchased by a person expires.

(2) In this section, "program" includes controlling the length of time the tanning equipment is activated or turned on.
