The ST. JOHN'S Urban Region Regional Plan is amended by re-designating land in the area of East White Hills Road, St. John's, from "Restricted" and "Public Open Space" to "Rural". Take notice that the ST. JOHN'S Municipal Plan Amendment Number 113, 2013, and the ST. JOHN'S Development Regulations Amendment Number 567, 2013, adopted on the 20^{th} day of January, 2014 and approved on the 28^{th} day of April, 2014, have been registered by the Minister of Municipal and Intergovernmental Affairs.

In general terms, the purpose of Municipal Plan Amendment Number 113, 2013, is to redesignate land in the area of East White Hills Road from the Rural Land Use District to the Industrial Land Use District.

In general terms, the purpose of Development Regulations Amendment Number 567, 2013, is to rezone land in the area of East White Hills Road from the Rural (R) Zone and the Commercial Industrial (CI) Zone to the Industrial General (IG) Zone.


