The Canada-Newfoundland and Labrador Offshore Petroleum Board hereby gives notice of a call for the submission of bids in respect of one parcel in the Newfoundland and Labrador offshore area.

This notice of the Call for Bids No. NL14-01 is made pursuant and subject to the *Canada-Newfoundland Atlantic Accord Implementation Act*, S.C., 1987, c. 3, and the *Canada-Newfoundland and Labrador Atlantic Accord Implementation Newfoundland and Labrador Act*, RSNL1990 cC-2.

The following is a summary of the Call for Bids No. NL14-01:

- (i) Sealed bids will be received by the Board prior to the time of closing of this Call for Bids No. NL14-01. This call for bids will close at 11:30 a.m., Newfoundland Standard Time, on December 12, 2014, except as specifically provided for in the Call for Bids No. NL14-01.
- (ii) All bids must be submitted in accordance with the terms and conditions of the Call for Bids No. NL14-01.
- (iii) The parcel is located offshore Newfoundland and Labrador and is described in Schedule I. An Exploration Licence may be issued for this parcel.
- (iv) For the purpose of selecting a bid, the sole criterion to be used will be the total amount of money the bidder commits to expend on exploration on the parcel within Period I ("Work Expenditure Bid").
- (v) The minimum Work Expenditure Bid will be \$10 million for the parcel offered in this Call for Bids.
- (vi) Allowable expenditures may be claimed for those permitted expenses incurred from the date of the initial announcement of the call for bids up to and including the effective date of the licence. - (ix) The Work Expenditure Bid must be accompanied by a bank draft or certified cheque in the amount of \$10,000 ("Bid Deposit") made payable to the Receiver General. Furthermore, the successful bidder will be required to provide, within 15 days of notification of being the successful bidder, a promissory note in the amount of 25% of the Work Expenditure Bid ("Security Deposit"). A credit against the Security Deposit will be made on the basis of 25% of allowable expenditures as described in the Exploration Licence ("Allowable Expenditures").

Carry forward provisions to reduce rentals otherwise payable in ensuing rental years will apply.

2. Water and sewage tax rate

Short title

1. These regulations may be cited as the *Water and Sewage Tax* Rate for the Hydroelectric Generating Plant located in the Town of Bishop's Falls Regulations.

Water and sewage tax rate

2. (1) The water and sewage tax rate imposed by the council for the Hydroelectric Generating Plant located in the Town of Bishop's Falls shall be calculated by multiplying the mill rate by the assessed value.

- (2) In subsection (1)
- (a) "mill rate" means the same mill rate applied by the council to all commercial properties in the town; and
- (b) "assessed value" means the assessed value of the Hydroelectric Generating Plant as assessed in accordance with the *Assessment Act*, 2006.
- (3) Notwithstanding subsection (1), the maximum allowable mill rate shall not exceed the mill rate imposed on other commercial properties in the town.
