In general terms, the purpose of Municipal Plan Amendment Number 125, 2014, is to redesignate land at Civic Numbers 48-56 Bay Bulls Road [Parcel ID #37279] from the Open Space (O) Land Use District to the Residential Low Density (RLD) Land Use District

In general terms, the purpose of Development Regulations Amendment Number 598, 2014, is to rezone land at Civic Numbers 48-56 Bay Bulls Road [Parcel ID #37279] from the Residential Low Density (R1) Zone and the Open Space (O) Zone to the Residential Medium Density (R2) Zone

TAKE NOTICE that the TOWN OF GLOVERTOWN Development Regulations Amendment No. 2, 2014 adopted on the 30th day of April, 2014, and approved (as amended) on the 15th day of August, 2014, has been registered by the Minister of Municipal and Intergovernmental Affairs.

In general terms, the purpose of Development Regulations Amendment No. 2, 2014 is to give Council discretionary authority, to exempt certain types of lots from Regulation 67 of the General Development Standards. Regulations 67 prohibits the erection of a residential or commercial building on a lot that does not front directly onto a street. The amendment will apply to the Seasonal Residential, Rural Resource, and Agriculture zones.

The Development Regulations Amendment No. 2, 2014 come into effect on the day that this notice is published in *The Newfoundland and Labrador Gazette*. Anyone who

1. This Order may be cited as the *Biogas Project Exemption Order*.

Definition

2. In this Order, "biogas project" means a biogas or landfill gas generating facility in the province.

Exemption

3. Newfoundland and Labrador Hydro is exempt from the *Electrical Power Control Act, 1994* and the *Public Utilities Act* for all

aspects of its activities respecting the purchase of electrical power and energy from a biogas project under a power purchase agreement with a producer, including the integration of electrical power and energy from a biogas project into Newfoundland and Labrador Hydro's forecasting, system planning, system engineering and supply.

1. Paragraph 4(1)(a) of the *Bus Regulations* is repealed and the following substituted:

(a) one of the following lamp systems:

- (i) 2 lamps which shall emit flashes of red light mounted on the front of the bus and 2 lights of the same type mounted on the rear of the bus,

- (ii) 4 lamps which shall emit flashes of red light mounted on the front of the bus and 4 lamps of the same type mounted on the rear of the bus, or
- (iii) 2 lamps which shall emit flashes of red and 2 lamps which shall emit flashes of yellow mounted on the front of the bus and 4 lamps of the same type mounted on the rear of the bus; and

Commencement

2. These regulations come into force on September 12, 2014.
