Endangered Species List Regulations (Amendment) under the Endangered Species Act (O.C. 2015-097)

(Filed April 21, 2015)

Under the authority of sections 7 and 44 of the *Endangered Species Act*, the Minister of Environment and Conservation, with the approval of the Lieutenant-Governor in Council, makes the following regulations.

NLR 57/02 as amended

- 1. Schedule A of the *Endangered Species List Regulations* is amended by
 - (a) adding immediately after the species "Feathery False Solomon's Seal- *Maianthemum racemosum* subsp. racemosum" the species "Gmelin's Watercrowfoot Ranunculus gmelinii";
 - (b) adding immediately after the species "Graceful Felt Lichen (Voles Ears Lichen)-*Erioderma mollissimum*" the species "Griscom's Arnica *Arnica griscomii* subsp. griscomii"; and
 - (c) adding immediately after the species "Wolverine-Gulo gulo" the species "Wooly Arnica Arnica angustifolia subsp. tomentosa".
- 2. Schedule B of the regulations is amended by adding immediately after the species "Sharpleaf Aster- Oclemena acuminata" the species "Tradescant's Aster- Symphyotrichum tradescantii".
 - 3. Schedule C of the regulations is amended by
 - (a) adding immediately after the species "Barrow's Goldeneye Bucephala islandica" the species Blue Felt Lichen Degelia plumbea; and
 - (b) adding immediately after the species "Short-eared owl-Asio flammeus" the species "Water Pygmyweed- Tillaea aquatica".
