



TO ALL TO WHOM THESE PRESENTS SHALL COME, GREETING:

A PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS in and by section 18 of An Act Respecting the Atlantic Provinces Harness Racing Commission, SNL2014 cA-19.1 (the "Act") it is provided that the Act shall come into force on a day to be fixed by Proclamation of Our Lieutenant Governor in Council;

AND WHEREAS it is deemed expedient that the Act shall now come into force:

NOW KNOW YE, THAT WE, by and with the advice of Our Executive Council of Our Province of Newfoundland and Labrador, do by this our Proclamation declare and direct that *An Act Respecting the Atlantic Provinces Harness Racing Commission*, SNL2014 cA-19.1 shall come into force on October 9, 2015.

OF ALL WHICH OUR LOVING SUBJECTS AND ALL OTHERS whom these Presents may concern are hereby required to take notice and to govern themselves accordingly.
