Then east following the Flowers Cove municipal boundary, to a road, a distance of 154 metres, more or less, closest to map coordinates 5,686,339 metres north and 254,680 metres east;

Then running in a northwesterly direction for a distance of 129 metres, more or less, to a point having scaled UTM coordinates of easting 575,602 metres and northing 6,265,510 metres;

Then running in a northwesterly direction for a distance of 214 metres, more or less, to a point having scaled UTM coordinates of easting 575,496 metres and northing 6,265,696 metres;

Then running in a northerly direction for a distance of 262 metres, more or less, to a point having scaled UTM coordinates of easting 575,426 metres and northing 6,265,948 metres;

Then running in a westerly direction for a distance of 410 metres, more or less, to a point having scaled UTM coordinates of easting 575,020 metres and northing 6,265,892 metres;
