### NEWFOUNDLAND AND LABRADOR REGULATION 12/17

Labour Standards Regulations (Amendment) under the Labour Standards Act (O.C. 2017-078)

(Filed March 1, 2017)

Under the authority of sections 26 and 27 of the *Labour Standards Act*, the Lieutenant-Governor in Council makes the following regulations.

1. S.8 R&S Minimum wage S.9 Amdt.
 Overtime wage

 Commencement

CNLR 781/96 as amended

1. Section 8 of the *Labour Standards Regulations* is repealed and the following substituted:

Minimum wage

- **8.** (1) Effective April 1, 2017, every employer shall pay to every employee a wage rate of not less than \$10.75 per hour.
- (2) Effective October 1, 2017, every employer shall pay to every employee a wage rate of not less than \$11.00 per hour.

## 2. Subsections 9(1) and (2) of the regulations are repealed and the following substituted:

Overtime wage

- **9.** (1) Effective April 1, 2017, for the purpose of section 25 of the Act, overtime wages shall be paid at a rate of not less than \$16.13 per hour
- (2) Effective October 1, 2017, for the purpose of section 25 of the Act, overtime wages shall be paid at a rate of not less than \$16.50 per hour.

Commencement

3. These regulations come into force on April 1, 2017.
