TAKE NOTICE that the CITY OF CORNER BROOK Development Regulations Amendment DR17-05, adopted on the 21st day of August, 2017, has been registered by the Minister of Municipal Affairs and Environment.

In general terms Development Regulations Amendment DR17-05 is necessary to create a new land use zoning map, Map C5 in order to identify the land use zoning of land beyond the more developed areas of the CITY OF CORNER BROOK (currently identified on Maps C-1, C-2, C-3 and C-4) and to correspond with the land use designations identified on the Integrated Municipal Sustainability Map A and Map B. Currently only Land Use Designation Maps A and B exist for these areas. Zoning amendments for these outlying areas may also then be identified and processed.
