The following Practice Note is published pursuant to Rule 4.04 of the Rules of the Supreme Court, 1986.

IMPROPERLY TITLED FORMS AND DOCUMENTS

Background and Purpose

1. On January 1, 2018, “The Trial Division of the Supreme Court” became “The Supreme Court of Newfoundland and Labrador” following the enactment of the *Court of Appeal Act*, which established the Court of Appeal of Newfoundland and Labrador as a separate and independent court.

2. Following this, amendments to the *Rules of the Supreme Court, 1986*, which came into force on February 9, 2018, amended 4.01(3) so that it now provides:

4.01 (3) All proceedings started in the province over which the General Division has jurisdiction shall be titled, “**In the Supreme Court of Newfoundland and Labrador, General Division**” and proceedings started in the province over which the Family Division has jurisdiction shall be titled, “**In the Supreme Court of Newfoundland and Labrador, Family Division**”. [Emphasis added.]

3. The Amendments similarly amended all of the forms to remove the words “Trial Division” from their included title. The use of these newly revised forms is mandated by rule 4.01(1).
4. Despite the change in the court’s name and the amendments to the rules and the forms, parties continue to submit forms and documents titled, “In the Supreme Court of Newfoundland and Labrador, Trial Division”.

Practice Note:

5. Beginning on **June 22, 2018**, the Supreme Court will no longer accept documents and forms titled, “**In the Supreme Court of Newfoundland and Labrador, Trial Division**”. Documents and forms should instead be titled either “In the Supreme Court of Newfoundland and Labrador, General Division” or “In the Supreme Court of Newfoundland and Labrador, Family Division”, as applicable.
6. Notwithstanding paragraph 5, a registry clerk shall accept an improperly titled originating document for filing if the refusal to accept the document on that date would result in the loss of a substantive right because of the expiration of a limitation period and this fact is brought to the clerk’s attention.

Short title	1. These regulations may be cited as the <i>Financial Administration Regulations</i> .
Definitions	2. In these regulations <ul style="list-style-type: none">(a) "Act" means the <i>Financial Administration Act</i>;(b) "community-based organization" means an organization that is representative of a community or a significant segment of a community and is engaged in meeting social and community needs; and(c) "multi-year grant" means an agreement entered into for funds to be granted in a subsequent fiscal year in accordance with subsection 26(4.1) of the Act;
Eligibility	3. A multi-year grant may only be issued to a community-based organization.
Eligibility criteria	4. The Lieutenant-Governor in Council may authorize a multi-year grant where the community-based organization satisfies the following criteria: <ul style="list-style-type: none">(a) it submits a completed grant funding application to the department responsible for the grant in the form and manner determined by the minister of that department;(b) it is incorporated under the <i>Corporations Act</i> and is in good standing;(c) it operates in the province and its head office is located in the province;(d) it has operated for a minimum of 3 years at the time it submits its application; and(e) it has received previous funding from government and it satisfied previous performance and reporting requirements.
Term	5. A multi-year grant shall only be issued for a maximum term of 3 fiscal years.

Reporting	<p>6. A community-based organization that receives a multi-year grant shall submit the reports and other documents required to be submitted under the multi-year grant to the minister of the department responsible for the grant in the time and manner determined by that minister.</p>
Revocation	<p>7. The Lieutenant-Governor in Council may revoke a multi-year grant where the community-based organization contravenes a term of the multi-year grant.</p>
Review	<p>8. (1) The minister shall, every 5 years, conduct a review of these regulations and consider the areas which may be improved</p>

1. The *Newfoundland and Labrador T'Railway Provincial Park Proclamation* is amended by adding at the end of the Schedule the following:

The area described in this Schedule is decreased by removing the following parcel of land:

All that piece or parcel of land situate and being in the Town of Bishop's Falls, in the Electoral District of Exploits, in the Province of Newfoundland and Labrador, abutted and bounded as follows, that is to say:
