Short title

1. This Order may be cited as the *Wolf Hunting Order*, *Newfoundland and Labrador*.

Definition

2. In this Order, "licence" means a licence issued under section 15 of the *Wild Life Regulations*.

Devices permitted

- 3. A person shall only shoot a wolf under a licence using
 - (a) a centre-fire rifle not greater than .225 calibre; or
 - (b) a shotgun using shot size 2 or larger.

Bag limit

4. The bag limit shall be one wolf per licence.
