Proclamation bringing remainder of Act into force (SNL 2012 c.21) (December 1, 2018) under An Act to Amend the Labrador Inuit Land Claims Agreement Act (O.C. 2018-250)

TO ALL TO WHOM THESE PRESENTS SHALL COME,

GREETING;

A PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS in and by subsection 5(1) of *An Act to Amend the Labrador Inuit Land Claims Agreement Act*, SNL2012, c21 (the "Act") it is provided that this Act comes into force on a day to be proclaimed by the Lieutenant-Governor in Council;

AND WHEREAS in and by subsection 5(2) of the Act it is provided that sections 1, 2 and 3 of the Act and sections 6, 7, 8, 9, 10, 11, 24 and 25 of the Memorandum of Agreement referenced in section 4 of the Act are considered to have come into force on December 1, 2005;

AND WHEREAS it is deemed expedient that the remainder of the Act shall come into force on December 1st, 2018;

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NOW KNOW YE, THAT WE, by and with the advice of Our Executive Council of Our Province of Newfoundland and Labrador, do by this our Proclamation declare and direct that *An Act to Amend the Labrador Inuit Land Claims Agreement Act*, SNL2012, c21 shall be proclaimed into force on December 1st, 2018.

OF ALL WHICH OUR LOVING SUBJECTS AND ALL OTHERS whom these Presents may concern are hereby required to take notice and to govern themselves accordingly.
