Information contained in this bulletin does not negate the responsibility of Electrical Contractors, and others, to comply with the requirements of the Canadian Electrical Code, the *Public Safety Act*, the *Electrical Regulations* and the supply authority.

RE: Electrical Contractor Representative Inspection Reports

As of August 3rd, 2015 it will become mandatory that all Electrical Contractors, Codes 1, 2 and 3 throughout the Province complete the "Electrical Contractor Representative Report" (please see enclosed copy) for any request of an electrical inspection (e.g., "rough-in and service" and final).

In some areas of the Province it has been acceptable to telephone in the request for an electrical inspection. This method will no longer be acceptable and all pertinent information must be included on this form.

Please forward the completed Electrical Contractor Representative Report to the area in which the inspection is requested.
