## **Environmental Assessment Bulletin**

The Honourable Bernard Davis, Minister of Environment and Climate Change, has announced the following events relative to Part 10 Environmental Assessment of the Environmental Protection Act.

## UNDERTAKING REGISTERED:

#### Placentia Hiking Trail Proponent: Placentia Chamber of Commerce

(Reg. 2199)

The proponent proposes to develop a continuous 24-kilometre hiking trail network within the Town of Placentia that would link the region's historical and natural assets. The network would extend from Argentia to Point Verde, incorporating existing trails and dirt roads but would also require areas of new construction. Proposed activities include vegetation clearing, ditching, resurfacing with aggregate, and installation of culverts, boardwalks, footbridges and staircases. The undertaking was registered on May 19, 2022; the deadline for public comments is June 23, 2022; and the minister's decision is due by July 3, 2022.
