

### **The original Permit dated JULY 17, 2020 is amended as follows:**

Term 39 (removal of timber, brush, and slash in the area to be flooded) is replaced with the following:

- Vegetation removal requirements shall be included in the OMS manual.
- Regular cleaning of spillway trash racks shall be included in the OMS manual.
- To prevent damage to the dam and the blocking of the flow of water through the spillways, regular vegetation removal from the spillways and upstream face of the dam shall be completed.

**All other terms and conditions of the original Permit will apply and failure to comply with the terms and conditions of this amendment and the original Permit will render this Permit null and void, place the Permit Holder and their agent(s) in violation of the *Water Resources Act* and make the Permit Holder responsible for taking any remedial measures as may be prescribed by this Department.**
