Vendor Terms & Conditions

Commercial Category

1. For the purpose of this licence, all definitions and regulations as indicated in the *Environmental Protection Act, SNL 2002, c.E-14.2* and the *Pesticides Control Regulations 2012* shall apply.
2. A vendor cannot sell, store or otherwise handle commercial or restricted class pesticides without holding a valid Certified Vendor Licence. If a certified vendor is not available to complete a transaction or sale of a commercial or restricted class pesticide, the sale cannot be completed at that time.
3. A vendor who sells commercial or restricted class pesticides must keep these products in a secure locked facility accessible only to the certified vendor on staff.
4. In accordance with Section 14 of the *Pesticides Control Regulations, 2012*, the vendor shall not sell any pesticide registered for use only on lawns which contain any of the following active ingredients:
 - a. 2,4-dichlorophenoxyacetic acid, commonly referred to as **2,4-D**;
 - b. **Mecoprop**;
 - c. **Dicamba**;
 - d. 2-methyl-4chlorophenoxyacetic acid, commonly referred to as **MCPA**; or **Carbaryl**.
5. A commercial vendor may only sell the above noted pesticides to an operator with a landscape category provided that the operator has a permit from the Pesticides Control Section to purchase the above noted products for use on turf.
6. A vendor may not sell a commercial or restricted class pesticide to anyone other than a licenced pesticide operator unless the product is designated on the label for agricultural use and the purchaser is a licensed applicator with a current agricultural designation. Please note that at this time the purchase of an agricultural product by a licensed applicator with a current greenhouse designation is also permitted.

7. All sales to a licensed pesticide operator shall be billed directly to the operator such that an individual cannot purchase pesticides under an operator licence for personal use. Therefore there shall be no cash sales on behalf of a licensed pesticide operator.
8. A vendor shall not supply a pesticide to an operator that is not listed on the pesticide operator's Appendix A, Pesticide List as supplied to the operator by the Pesticides Control Section.
9. An applicator (Agricultural, Greenhouse) must have a valid licence on their person at the time of purchase.
10. A pesticide operator must supply a copy of their valid pesticide operator licence at the time of purchase.
11. With respect to stipulations # 5 & 6 mail orders must contain a copy of the applicable licence.
12. As per section 12 of the Pesticides Control Regulations 2012; A pesticide vendor shall keep, in a form and manner required by the minister or a person designated by the minister, a record of each purchase and sale of a pesticide.
13. With respect to the above stipulation, the vendor shall provide an annual sales summary of all commercial and or restricted class pesticides sold, to the Pesticides Control Section by February 28th of each year. The information required in this sales summary will be as follows;

Record of sales to purchaser

- (a) Name of the purchaser
 - (b) POL # (Pesticide Operator Licence Number)
 - (c) PAL # (If agriculture class pesticide sold to farmer with an Agriculture or Greenhouse pesticide applicator licence)
 - (d) Date of sale of pesticide
 - (e) Type and Quantity sold
 - (f) Unit of measure
