Re: Waste Management Plan for the Port Kirwan Abattoir

On June 2, 2022, you submitted a Waste Management Plan to the Pollution Prevention Division. The plan was found to be acceptable by the Pollution Prevention Division, and is therefore approved.

The plan was submitted in fulfillment of the following condition in my decision letter of October 21, 2021, releasing the Port Kirwan Abattoir project from further environmental assessment:

"You are required to prepare a Waste Management Plan that covers all solid and liquid waste generated by the proposed facility and submit it for approval by the Pollution Prevention Division of my Department prior to the facility going into operation. The plan must also include information on your vector and odour controls."
