

The original Permit dated SEPTEMBER 24, 2019 is amended as follows:

This Permit is amended to extend the expiry date from December 31, 2022 to December 31, 2026 and to add the following condition:

32. An annual report outlining the harvesting and road construction activities completed within the Protected Public Water Supply Area from January 1 to December 31 must be submitted to the Environmental Scientist at trentpollett@gov.nl.ca for each year this Permit is valid. The report must be submitted by January 15 the following year. If no forestry activities have taken place during a reporting period, the Environmental Scientist must be notified.

All other terms and conditions of the original Permit will apply and failure to comply with the terms and conditions of this amendment and the original Permit will render this Permit null and void, place the Permit Holder and their agent (s) in violation of the *Water Resources Act* and make the Permit Holder responsible for taking any remedial measures as may be prescribed by this Department.
