The original Permit dated AUGUST 30, 2021 is amended as follows:

This Permit is amended to add the following conditions:

31. Fill material must be obtained from an approved quarry site. It must not be taken from beaches or streams, and must not be dredged from a body of water.

32. Removal of streambank vegetation or trees is not permitted. Overhanging brush that collects snow and blocks ice movement may be pruned and cut back to allow free flow of water.


33. Where sand or gravel is used in the construction of trails, these areas must be closely monitored during and after periods of heavy rainfall for any signs of erosion or washout.

34. Trail embankments near watercourses must be adequately protected from erosion by sodding, seeding or placing of rip-rap.

35. Permit Holder must avoid construction activities in a wetlands wherever possible.

36. Heavily travelled areas must be kept well drained to prevent the formation of mud puddles which can contribute to erosion and siltation events.

All other terms and conditions of the original Permit will apply and failure to comply with the terms and conditions of this amendment and the original Permit will render this Permit null and void, place the Permit Holder and their agent(s) in violation of the *Water Resources Act* and make the Permit Holder responsible for taking any remedial measures as may be prescribed by this Department.
