
Re: **Gander Lake WSMC - Gander Lake PPWSA - Resumption of Operations - Beaver Brook Antimony Mine Inc.**

**The original Permit dated JANUARY 30, 2019 is amended as follows:**

The following conditions are added to the permit:

- The felling or disposing of trees, parts of trees, sawdust, bark, logging debris or slash into a water body or upon the frozen surface of a water body is strictly prohibited.
- For any clearing inside buffer zones: no ground disturbance (no disturbance to the root mat, no grubbing, or removal of soil) shall take place in the buffer zones. The Permit Holder is to ensure that the appropriate best practices are employed to prevent any detrimental effects that could impact water quality. Where possible, work in buffer zones shall be completed when the ground is frozen.
- A Wood Harvesting Permit is required from the Regional Services Division of the Forestry Services Branch for any wood cutting activities.

All other terms and conditions of the original Permit will apply and failure to comply with the terms and conditions of this amendment and the original Permit will render this Permit null and void, place the Permit Holder and their agent(s) in violation of the *Water Resources Act* and make the Permit Holder responsible for taking any remedial measures as may be prescribed by this Department.
