
APPENDIX A **Terms and Conditions for Amendment**

- 1. Based on information provided on June 10, July 15 and August 29 & 31, 2022, the scope of work is changed to include:
 - the removal of over burden where required to complete 7 channels for a total length of 230m within the same contour lines as shown in the attached site plan, and
 - b. installation of a water intake in Fox Harbour Pond, at the location identified on mapping provided August 31, 2022 and titled Fox Harbour Pond Proposed Pump Setup.
- 2. Channel work will be completed by using a diamond saw, chisel and hammer. Water will be used to cool the diamond saw.
- 3. A buffer of 50m is required around Fox Harbour Pond and there will be no fuel storage inside the buffer.
- 4. Fuel is only to be on site when gas generator and diesel pumps are in use.
- 5. All Fuel Storage requirements from PRO12511-2022 are to be met.
- 6. Spill kits are required at both the gas generator site and diesel pump site.
- 7. All pump infrastructure is to be removed at the end of the 2022 exploration season. Photos to be taken of the area and submitted to the Environmental Scientist with the Completion Report (Appendix C of PRO12511-2022).
- 8. Continue to monitor Tub Harbour Pond per the conditions of PRO12511-2022.
- 9. Forward all water quality data for samples collected to date in Fox Harbour Pond to the Environmental Scientist. If not already doing so, include BTEX/TPH and PAH parameters for the Fox Harbour Pond location as indicated in the map submitted August 31, 2022 and titled Deep Fox Proposed Water Access Location and Trail.


