Incomplete applications will not be considered.

Applications submitted during the 2019-2020 Call for Applications (closed December 2018) will be considered if the applicant informs MAE by emailing <a href="mailto:lnfrastructureMAE@gov.nl.ca">lnfrastructureMAE@gov.nl.ca</a>. This email must include the following:

- 1. Email subject line"Town of {insert town name} Resubmission of Application —AP-MCW-{insert 5 digit number}"
- 2. An updated Resolution of Council for the specific project Application citing the application number, title and total project cost.
- 3. ICIP Stream Application (ICIP ONLY)
- 4. Aboriginal Consultation and Environmental Assessment form (ICIP ONLY)
- 5. An updated cost estimate. If no updated cost estimate is received, it will be assumed that the former estimate is still accurate and evaluation will be based on that.
