Valentine Gold Project

(Reg. 2015)

Proponent: Marathon Gold Corporation.

The proponent is planning to develop an open pit gold mine approximately 55 kilometres southwest of Millertown in the central region. The Minister of Environment, Climate Change and Municipalities is seeking public comments on the environmental impact statement (EIS), a document that describes the project and provides an overview of the potential environmental effects of all phases of the project.
