NEW UNDERTAKINGS REGISTERED:

Recreation Vehicle (R.V.) Park and Trail Expansion
Proponent: Town of Springdale

The proponent proposes to develop a Caravan/Recreation Vehicle (R.V.) Park at Springdale as an extension to the George Huxter Municipal Park. The planned expansion to the park will include construction of approximately 20 R.V. sites with sewer and electrical hook-up and 2.5 kilometres of walking trails. The undertaking was registered on November 10, 2000; public comments are due on December 19, 2000; and the Minister's decision is due on December 25, 2000.
