UNDERTAKING REGISTERED:

Roddickton Underground Salmon Pool Viewing
Proponent: White Bay Central Development Association

The proponent proposes a viewing platform and an upgraded walking trail to an underground salmon pool on Beaver Brook. The Brook is a scheduled salmon river located 14 km from the Town of Roddickton, 5 km from the intersection of Routes 432 and 433. Project activities include upgrading 2.6 km of access road and construction of: 500 m of walking trail, 100 m of board walk, a viewing area around the underground pool and an interpretation site. The project was registered on May 29, 2001, public comments are due July 4 and the Minister's decision is due July 13.
