NEW UNDERTAKING REGISTERED:

ATV Trail, near Frenchman's Cove, Burin Peninsula
Proponent: Mr. Wilfred Tibbo

The proponent is proposing to construct an ATV trail from Route 210 near Frenchman's Cove to a private remote cottage. The proposed trail would be approximately 5.0 km long and constructed to a standard suitable for 4-wheeler ATVs and snowmobiles. The undertaking was registered on October 30, 2001. Public comments are due on December 7, 2001, and the Ministers decision is due December 14, 2001.
