UNDERTAKING REGISTERED:

Amendment to Five-Year Plan (1998 - 2002) for Forest Management Districts 10,11and 12. (Duck Pond, Sluice Brook, Patchy Valley and Golden Gullies Road in Central Newfoundland) Proponent: Abitibi Consolidated

The Proponent proposes to amend the current Five Year Operating Plan for five operating areas, all of which are located within District 11 and are intended to encompass a portion of the 2002 Annual Work Schedule for this District.

The proponent maintains that the areas are required to sustain operations within the year 2002 until a new Five Year Operating Plan is developed for the planning period 2003 to 2007.

The undertaking was registered on November 29, 2001, public comments are due January 4, 2002, and the Minister's decision is due on January 13, 2002.
