NEW UNDERTAKINGS REGISTERED:

Bellmans Pond (Glenwood) Forest Access Road Proponent: A. L. Stuckless and Sons Ltd.

The proponent proposes to construct a forest access road to access timber in Forest Management District 8, in the vicinity of Bellmans Pond and Gander River. The fibre harvested will be utilized at the A. L. Stuckless and Sons Ltd. sawmill in Glenwood and at a value added plant in Springdale. The road construction is tentatively scheduled to begin early in 2002. The undertaking was registered on December 27, 2001, public comments are due February 6, 2002 and the Minister's decision is due on February 10, 2002.
