(2) Glenwood Composting Facility

(Reg. 1153)

Proponent: North Atlantic Lumber Inc.

The Minister has released the Glenwood Composting project from further environmental assessment subject to the following preconditions:

- Proof of financial assurances in the form of \$1,000,000 environmental liability insurance,
 \$100,000 guaranteed letter of credit from a recognized lending institution and \$1,000,000 vehicle liability insurance;
- Obtaining an amendment or revocation of an Order of the Office of the Fire Commissioner dated 30 April, 2003; and,
- Proof of revocation, or compliance with the amendment, of the Order of the Office of the Fire Commissioner.

Williams Harbour (Labrador) Access Road (Reg. 1097)
Proponent: Department of Transportation and Works

The proponent has withdrawn the above undertaking from environmental assessment review.
