- preparation of a bird monitoring program, in consultation with the Inland Fish and Wildlife Division and the Canadian Wildlife Service, which is required to be submitted to the Minister of Environment and Conservation for approval, and
- areas outside the safety zone of the turbine structures are to be available for public use.
