The Minister has advised the proponent that an Environmental Impact Statement (EIS) is required for this project. The EIS will be required to examine among other things: air quality, effluent quality, migratory birds, fish and fish habitat, water resources, aquaculture, historic resources and the socio-economic environment. An Environmental Assessment Committee will be appointed to provide scientific and technical advice to the Minister and to prepare draft guidelines for conducting the EIS. The public will be invited to provide comment on the draft guidelines.
