Environment and Conservation Minister Clyde Jackman has announced the following event relative to Part 10 Environmental Assessment of the Environmental Protection Act.

UNDERTAKING RELEASED:

Grassy Point (Placentia Bay) Liquefied Natural Gas (LNG) Transshipment Terminal
Proponent: Newfoundland LNG Limited (Reg. 1304)

The Minister has released the above project from further environmental assessment, subject to the following conditions:

- An Employment Equity Plan must be submitted to and approved by the Minister of Environment and Conservation prior the start of construction.
- A Risk Assessment Study must be submitted to and approved by the Minister of Environment and Conservation prior to the start of construction and issuance of necessary Crown Lands.
- An Environmental Protection Plan (EPP) must be submitted to and approved by the Minister of Environment and Conservation prior the start of construction.
