## **ENVIRONMENTAL ASSESSMENT BULLETIN**

Environment and Conservation Minister Honourable Clyde Jackman has announced the following events relative to Part 10 Environmental Assessment of the Environmental Protection Act.

### **UNDERTAKING REGISTERED:**

**Deer Lake Hotel Development** (Reg. 1348)  
**Proponent: Resource Development Associates Inc./Winport Developments Inc.**

The proposal is to construct an 82 room hotel in the Town of Deer Lake. The site is bounded by the Trans Canada Highway to the south and Great Northern Peninsula Highway to the west and the Humber River to the north. Construction is to commence in the Fall of 2007, pending approval, over a 12-month period.

The undertaking was registered on August 30, 2007; public comments are due by October 5, 2007; and, the Minister's decision is due by October 14, 2007.

Comments on submitted documents are invited from the public, addressed in writing to the Minister, prior to the deadline date shown.

**Freshwater Component Study**  
**Long Harbour Commercial Nickel Processing Plant**  
**Proponent: Voiseys Bay Nickel Company Limited** (Reg. 1243)
