This undertaking was released from environmental assessment subject to the following conditions:

- The area is under timber license to Corner Brook Pulp and Paper Limited (CBPP). Prior to any cutting of timber on this project site, the proponent must contact CBPP concerning the harvesting of the timber.
- The proponent must develop a buffer zone plan in consultation with the Wildlife Division of the Department of Environment and Conservation to minimize impacts on water bodies. Tees and greens are to be 50 metres from the high water mark and fairways are to be 20 metres from the high water mark.
