The Honourable Charlene Johnson, Minister of Environment and Conservation, has announced the following events relative to Part 10 Environmental Assessment of the Environmental Protection Act.

Mary's Harbour Crab Processing Facility (Reg 1508)
Proponent: Labrador Fishermen's Union Shrimp Company Limited (LFUSC)

Northern Labrador 5 Year Operating Plan Forest District 23 (2008-2012)
Proponent: Newfoundland and Labrador Forest Service (Reg. 1506)

Tommy's Pond ATV Trail (Reg. 1499)
Proponent: Mr. Randy Adams

Rocky Harbour Cottage Development Plan, Amendment No. 4 (Reg. 1490)
Proponent: Dept. of Environment and Conservation, Land Management Division

This undertaking was released from environmental assessment subject to the following condition:

- A minimum 30 meter undisturbed vegetated buffer must be maintained between the proposed cottage development area and any water body.

Labrador, Hutton Garnet Beaches – South Beach Bulk Sampling (Reg.1486)
Proponent: Freeport Resources Inc.

This undertaking was released from environmental assessment subject to the following conditions:

- Bulk sampling shall not proceed until a bird survey verifies that shorebirds are not nesting at the site; and,
- A Work Plan must be approved by the Department of Natural Resources, Mineral Lands Division and the Nunatsiavut Government prior to the commencement of the bulk sampling program.
