The Honourable Charlene Johnson, Minister of Environment and Conservation, has announced the following event relative to Part 10 Environmental Assessment of the Environmental Protection Act.

UNDERTAKING REGISTERED:

Garnish to Point Rosie All Terrain Vehicle (ATV) Trail (Reg.1535)

Proponent: Garnish-Point Rosie Trail Association Inc.

The proponent plans to extend an existing ATV trail system to allow linkage of the Marystown Garnish Pond Trail system to the Garnish Trail (encompassing a section of trail previously approved). A total of 12 kilometres of trail will be upgraded/constructed. Work associated with construction is expected to take approximately 40 days and will employ 5 people. The undertaking is scheduled is begin in June 2011.

The undertaking was registered October 13, 2010; public comments are due by November 19, 2010; and the minister's decision is due by November 27, 2010.
