The project is released subject to the following conditions:

- Access to the site must be via the route indicated as Access Option # 1. Access from the T'Railway Park is not permitted.
- A minimum 50-metre undisturbed vegetated buffer must be maintained along all waterbodies and wetlands to protect sensitive species and their habitat.
- A minimum 100-metre undisturbed vegetated buffer must be maintained from the shoreline of Highlands River.
