A review has been completed of the Environmental Impact Statement (EIS) submitted April 12, 2012, and the additional EIS information submitted December 10, 2012. These documents comply with Part X of the *Environmental Protection Act* (the Act) and the EIS Guidelines and Scoping Document dated May 2011, and require no further work. The Minister will now be recommending to the Lieutenant-Governor in Council whether or not this Project can proceed as per Section 67 of the Act, subject to terms and conditions.
