## **Environmental Assessment Bulletin**

The Honourable Perry Trimper, Minister of Environment and Conservation, has announced the following events relative to Part 10 Environmental Assessment of the *Environmental Protection Act*.

### **MINISTER'S DECISION EXTENDED:**

**Long Pond Weir**

(Reg. 1783)

**Proponent: City of St. John's**

The Department of Environment and Conservation and the proponent have agreed to extend the deadline for public comments to April 28, 2016; and the minister's decision to May 8, 2016.

### **ERRATUM:**

The proponent for the proposed Long Pond Weir project advises that there are errors in flood maps provided in Appendix R of the Environmental Preview Report (EPR) for the above undertaking. Specifically, maps illustrating the 1:5 AEP + 30% and the 1:20 AEP + 30% pre and post weir construction floodplains are incorrect. A revised Appendix R, which includes maps illustrating the correct floodplains, has been placed on the Department's website at the link below:
