### **Environmental Assessment Bulletin**

The Honourable Perry Trimper, Minister of Environment and Climate Change, has announced the following events relative to Part 10 Environmental Assessment of the *Environmental Protection Act*.

#### **MINISTER'S DECISION ON THE APPEAL:**

**Placentia Bay Atlantic Salmon Aquaculture Project** (Reg. 1834)  
**Proponent: Grieg NL Nurseries Ltd. and Grieg NL Seafarms Ltd.**

On July 22, 2016 the minister released the above undertaking from further environmental assessment. The decision was appealed August 31, 2016 in accordance with Section 107 of the *Environmental Protection Act*. The minister has considered the appeal documents and has determined that the original decision to release the project from further environmental assessment will remain in effect.
