The Honourable Eddie Joyce, Minister of Municipal Affairs and Environment, has announced the following events relative to Part 10 Environmental Assessment of the *Environmental Protection Act.*

UNDERTAKING REGISTERED:

New Bay Road Trauma Recovery Centre Proponent: Chiron Wellness Centre

(Reg.1896)

The proponent has submitted a proposal for the development of 19.32 hectares of land for the construction and operation of a 16-bedroom trauma recovery centre, located off New Bay Road approximately 6.5 km north of Wooddale Farms near Grand Falls – Windsor. The undertaking will involve the construction of the trauma recovery facility, accessory buildings, a network of walking trails and approximately 100 metres of new access road. The purpose of the project is to provide treatment in a peaceful rural setting to those who suffer with trauma. The project is scheduled to commence by fall 2017.

The undertaking was registered on May 29, 2017; the deadline for public comments is July 4, 2017; and the minister's decision is due by July 13, 2017.
