The Honourable Andrew Parsons, Minister of Municipal Affairs and Environment, has announced the following events relative to Part 10 Environmental Assessment of the Environmental Protection Act.

UNDERTAKING REGISTERED:

Point au Gaul Breakwater Upgrades Proponent: Town of Point au Gaul

(Reg. 1989)

The proponent is planning to construct a 150-metre rubble breakwater along the shoreline at Point au Gaul as an extension to the existing breakwater. The new breakwater will be 17 metres wide at its widest area. The breakwater is intended to mitigate the risk of flooding to nearby homes and properties and to stabilize the eroding shoreline.

The undertaking was registered on October 30, 2018; the deadline for public comments is December 7, 2018; and the minister's decision is due by December 14, 2018.

APPEAL OF MINISTER'S DECISION:

Placentia Bay Atlantic Salmon Aquaculture Project (Reg. 1834)
Proponent: Grieg NL Nurseries Ltd. and Grieg NL Seafarms Ltd.

On September 6, 2018, the minister announced that the environmental impact statement for the above-noted project is acceptable. On October 25, 2018, the minister received an appeal of that decision under section 107 of the Environmental Protection Act.
