Environmental Assessment Bulletin

The Honourable Graham Letto, Minister of Municipal Affairs and Environment, has announced the following events relative to Part 10 Environmental Assessment of the Environmental Protection Act.

UNDERTAKING REGISTERED:

Mount Pearl Stericycle Biomedical Waste Transfer and Treatment Facility Proponent: Stericycle, ULC (Reg. 1992)

The proponent is proposing to construct and operate a biomedical waste transfer and treatment facility at an existing building at 45 Clyde Avenue, Mount Pearl. This facility will remove, treat, and dispose of the biomedical waste collected in the province. Waste requiring disposal by incineration will be held in a refrigeration unit inside a warehouse until shipped to the proponent's existing Ontario facility. Waste that can be treated onsite will be autoclaved and sent to Robin Hood Bay Facility for final disposal.

The undertaking was registered on December 3, 2018; the deadline for public comments is January 9, 2019; and the minister's decision is due by January 17, 2019.

DRAFT ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT STATEMENT GUIDELINES FOR PUBLIC REVIEW:

Hope Brook Access Road Proponent: First mining Gold Corporation

(Reg. 1968)

The proposed Hope Brook Access Road between Route 480 (Burgeo Highway) and the Hope Brook mineral exploration property is undergoing a provincial environmental assessment, and an Environmental Impact Statement (EIS) is required. The Environmental Assessment Committee has prepared draft EIS guidelines that identify the information that must be included in the EIS. The public is invited to review these guidelines and provide written comments by January 14, 2019. Comments received will be reviewed and considered before the EIS guidelines are finalized and issued to the proponent.
