Deer Lake Microbrewery (Reg. 2003)

Cottage on the Upper Humber-North Branch River Junction (Reg. 2007)

Proponent: Michael Gorman

The project is released subject to the following condition:

 The proponent must maintain a minimum 30-metre naturally vegetated buffer along all waterbodies and wetlands to protect sensitive riparian and aquatic species, and their habitat.

West Bottom Brook Bridge Replacement (Reg. 2012)

Proponent: Department of Transportation and Works

Indian River RV Park (Reg. 2013)

Proponent: JSR Holdings Inc.

The project is released subject to the following conditions:

- For all proposed new development, a minimum 50-metre naturally vegetated buffer, which includes trees, is to be maintained along Indian River, which is a scheduled salmon river:
- A minimum 30-metre naturally vegetated buffer is to be maintained along all other waterbodies and wetlands to protect sensitive riparian and aquatic species, and their habitat.
