The project is released subject to the following conditions:

- The Crown land application number 154070 in the Moose Pond area is to be reduced in size to 48 hectares. This is required to preserve significant aggregate resources. Please contact the Mines Branch, Department of Natural Resources at (709) 729-5748 for exact boundary coordinates.
- The Crown land application number 154070 is near and up-gradient to an area with private drilled and dug wells. A 150 metre buffer must be maintained between the forage area and any properties with private groundwater supplies.
